Steps we will take onsite at the event:

- Hand sanitizer will be readily available throughout the event.
- Program materials will be distributed electronically.
- Masking will be subject to local and venue rules and restrictions. Of course, you may wear a mask during any function.

Tips for a Healthy Conference Environment:

Individuals who test positive for COVID-19 or who have been exposed to COVID-19 within five (5) days of the event should not attend and should abide by the [CDC](#) and [Prince George's County Department of Public Health](#) masking and COVID-19 quarantine guidelines.

Should an event participant test positive for COVID-19, register a temperature, or become ill during the event, he/she/they should observe recognized quarantining procedures.

Cancellation/Registration Transfer Policy:

- If you cannot attend the CSO50 Conference & Awards, you may transfer your registration to a qualified security, technology, or risk executive colleague or transfer any fees paid for the event toward another Foundry event held within 12 months of September 19, 2022.
